Dear Parents/Guardians of P2 - P6 Students,

Welcome to a new academic year at Anderson Primary School. To the new parents/guardians amongst us, a warm welcome to our Anderson Family. As we get ready to welcome all our P2 to P6 Andersonians back to school, we would like to thank all parents/guardians for your partnership in cobuilding a safe and nurturing learning environment for our students.

## 1. A Special Welcome: Vice-Principals Mr Thomas Boh and Ms Jasmine Tan

Anderson Primary School warmly welcomes Mr Thomas Boh (VP EO) and Ms Jasmine Tan (VP Admin), both of whom were posted to our school with effect from 15 Dec 2022. Mr Boh and Ms Tan have had many years of school leadership experience. Mr Boh was posted from Woodlands Ring Primary School, where he had served as the VP (EO) for nine years, while Ms Tan was posted from Si Ling Primary School, where she had served as VPA for eight years.

Mr Boh and Ms Tan will be supporting me in leading the school to provide authentic platforms for Andersonians to internalise and demonstrate good habits and values and shine the Anderson LIGHT. #### 2. Start of School on 4 Jan (Wed)

There is no school for P2 - P6 students on 3 Jan (Tue). The school year will start on 4 Jan 2023 (Wed). Our school-based SCC, operated by Commit Learning SchoolHouse, will be open from 1.30 pm on 3 Jan (Tue) for all SCC students.

Please refer to Annex A for our 2023 school hours, arrival and staggered dismissal timings. Morning flag-raising will start punctually at 7.30 am, followed by first period curriculum lessons. Students are considered late for school if they arrive after 7.30 am. All students are encouraged to arrive by 7.20 am.

#### On 4 Jan (Wed):

To facilitate our students' transition to the new school year, all students will go through Start Right!, an orientation programme on 4 Jan (Wed). For the first day of school, students will only need to bring their water bottles, snacks for snack break and stationery for classroom activities and a storybook. On 4 Jan, all students can come in their PE attire (PE T-shirt and shorts).


#### From 5 Jan (Thu):

Curriculum lessons will only begin from 5 Jan (Thu). The curriculum time-table will be issued to all students on 4 Jan (Wed). Your child's/ward's Form Teachers will also inform your child/ward on the books/files to bring on each day for the rest of the week. Students should be dressed in their PE attire on days with PE lessons and in their school uniform on non-PE days.

#### 3. Snack Break

There will be a snack break at 8.30 am (for P3, P4 & P5) or 12.00 pm (for P2 & P6) daily for about 10 minutes. We encourage you to prepare healthy snacks for your child/ward. #### 4. Storybook for Silent Reading

Before morning flag-raising at 7.30 am daily, all students are expected to read a book either in their respective classrooms or in the school hall. Please ensure that your child/ward brings a storybook to school daily.

## 5. <u>Student Well-Being & Temperature-Taking Exercise on 11 Jan (Wed)</u>

Please ensure that your child/ward brings a working thermometer to school daily. The school will be conducting a school-wide temperature-taking exercise on 11 Jan (Wed). All students are expected to take their temperatures with their personal thermometers to be reported to their Form Teachers.

If your child/ward feels unwell (e.g. sore throat, cough, fever and/or running nose), please keep your child/ward at home and bring him/her to see a doctor. If a medical certificate is issued, your child/ward can only return to school after the stipulated MC period.

If your child/ward has received a Covid-19 vaccination within 2 weeks before he/she attends school, please inform his/her Form Teacher about the date of vaccination. Your child/ward will be excused from any strenuous activities for 2 weeks from the day of vaccination.

#### 6. Form Teachers' Meet & Greet Sessions and Level Curriculum Briefings (from 16 Jan – 1 Feb)

Your child's/ward's Form Teachers will be arranging to meet you virtually through a meet & greet session. It will be a common Zoom meeting together with other parents of students from the same class, scheduled anytime from 16 Jan – 1 Feb. Your child's/ward's Form Teachers will provide more information via ClassDojo.

The school would also be sharing online resources to keep you updated about our level-based curriculum. Your child's/ward's Form Teachers will share the link to access the online resources with you after 16 Jan.

#### 7. After-School Programmes

In tandem with the removal of Mid-Year Exams (MYE) for all levels, the school will not be holding after-school supplementary lessons for P5 and P6 levels in 2023. The removal of MYE will free up curriculum time for teachers to reinforce and deepen students' learning.

Extended curriculum lessons for students taking Higher MTL, Foundation EL and/or Foundation Math are compulsory and will begin from Term 1 Week 3. The individual subject teachers will provide you with more details separately.

P3 and P4 students selected for SDR and RRP will continue to be supported in these after-school reading programmes. The SDR and RRP lessons will begin from Term 1 Week 3. The SDR and RRP teachers will provide you with more details separately.

To support students in their learning of the core subjects (EL, MTL, Math & Science), structured remedial lessons will be arranged and start from Term 1 Week 5. If your child/ward is selected for these remedial lessons, his/her subject teacher(s) will provide you with more details separately.

As a guide, all CCAs will start from Term 1 Week 5. Students participating in NSG will start their CCA practices earlier. CCA teachers will share more details on the CCA sessions with you separately. Please refer to Annex B for our 2023 CCA Schedule.

#### 8. <u>CNY Celebrations on 20 Jan (Fri) – no early dismissal</u>

There will be a school-based CNY celebration on 20 Jan (Fri). As it is not CNY Eve, there is no change to school hours (i.e. from 7.30 am to 1.00 pm/1.10 pm). School will close for CNY on 23 Jan (Mon) and 24 Jan (Tue), and resume on 25 Jan (Wed).

9. <u>EZLink School Smart Card Photo-Taking Exercise for P1 & P6 Students on 31 Jan (Tue)</u> The individual photo-taking exercise for P1 and P6 students will be held on 31 Jan (Tue). Students can come to school in their PE attire if they have PE lessons on that day.
