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Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to a new academic year at Anderson Primary School. To the new parents/guardians amongst us, a warm welcome to our Anderson Family.

We would also like to extend a very warm welcome to the parents/guardians of our Primary 1 cohort and all those who have just joined the Anderson family.

We look forward to another good year of partnership with you; as we welcome all our Andersonians back to school, we would like to thank all parents/guardians for your partnership in co-building a safe and nurturing learning environment for our students.

As we start the new term for 2024, we would like to draw your attention to the following school matters:

1. Attendance and Dismissal Procedure

- 1.1 Curriculum time during school days is precious and has been set aside for your child/ward to learn the required syllabus content so that he/she is adequately prepared for the various assessments over the terms. Hence, your child/ward is expected to be present during term time.
- 1.2 **Attendance** will be recorded as **ABSENT** without valid reasons unless supported by **Medical Certificate or relevant official documents.** Parents are discouraged from bringing their children out of school during term time unless there are exigencies to attend to.
- 1.3 Do also assist to monitor your child/ward regularly and ensure that he/she completes the homework assigned, be it physical worksheets or online assignments on Student Learning Space (SLS), so that he/she has the necessary practice and consolidation of his/her learning.

2. First Day of School on 2 Jan 2023 (Tue) for Primary 1 cohort

2.1 Class Allocation

The school has previously informed you of your child's/ward's form class and the programme for the first day of school through Parents Gateway (PG).

The information was sent out on 21 Dec 2023 by Year Head (Lower Primary), Ms Neo Hwee, When you log into PG, you will also be able to check your child's/ward's class. The class is indicated below your child's/ward's name in PG.













2.2 Reporting Details

All P1 students are to report to school on 2 Jan 2023 (Tue); you can bring your child to their respective classroom by 7.50 am.

The curriculum time-table will be issued to your child/ward on 2 Jan (Tue), including the list of learning materials to bring for the rest of the week.

As there are limited parking lots within the school compound, all parents/guardians who drive are to park at the nearest HDB carparks opposite the school.

2.3 Programme for Parents/Guardians

After settling your child/ward in his/her classroom, all parents/guardians will be ushered to attend a curriculum briefing in the hall. The briefing will begin at 8.00 am.

Please do refer to the PG notification shared earlier for the detailed programme.

2.4 Dismissal Arrangements

Dismissal Time	12.00pm	Pick-up on foot: Gates A and B will be open for parents'/guardians' pick up on foot.
		Pick up by vehicular drive-through: Parents/Guardians can only drive into the school from about 12.20 pm.
		All students enrolled in our school-based Student Care Centre (SCC) will be brought to the covered basketball court to have their attendance taken by their SCC coaches. We would like all SCC students to be familiar with the SCC daily reporting routines. If you'd like to pick your child/ward up earlier, pls arrange separately with the SCC.

3. First Week of School from 3 Jan to 5 Jan (Wed - Fri)

All students will report to school from 3 Jan (Wed). To facilitate all students' transition to the new school year, all students will go through Start Right!, a 1-day orientation programme on 3 Jan (Wed).

Curriculum lessons will only begin from 4 Jan (Thu). Students do not need to bring their books or files for the first day of school as there will be a special programme to ease them into the new academic year.

Please refer to **Annex A** for our 2024 school hours, arrival and staggered dismissal timings. Morning flag-raising will start punctually at 7.30 am, followed by first period curriculum lessons.

Students are considered late for school if they arrive after 7.30 am. All students are encouraged to arrive by 7.20 am.

4. Storybook for Silent Reading

Before morning flag-raising at 7.30 am daily, all students are expected to read a book either in their respective classrooms or in the school hall. Please do ensure that your child/ward brings a storybook to school daily.

5. Snack Break

- 5.1 To enhance the well-being of our Andersonians, a snack break in class is given daily so that they can have a small bite to tide them over the school day. Do take note that it is not a must for students to eat during this break as some do not require it.
- 5.2 Only dry snacks such as **biscuits**, **sandwiches or fruits** are allowed to be consumed in class during this snack break and students are not allowed to go to the canteen to buy food.

More importantly, please discourage your child from consuming unhealthy or junk food such as chips, chocolates and sweets.

7. Student Well-Being & Temperature-Taking Exercise on 10 Jan (Wed)

All P1 students will be issued with an Oral Digital Thermometer (ODT) within the first week of school. Please ensure that your child/ward brings a working thermometer to school daily.

The school will be conducting a school-wide temperature-taking exercise on 10 Jan (Wed). All students are expected to take their temperatures with their personal thermometers to be reported to their Form Teachers.

Should your child/ward feel unwell (e.g. sore throat, cough, fever and/or running nose), please keep your child/ward at home and bring him/her to see a doctor.

If a medical certificate is issued, your child/ward can only return to school after the stipulated MC period. If your child/ward has received a Covid-19 vaccination within 2 weeks before he/she attends school, please inform his/her Form Teacher about the date of vaccination.

Your child/ward will be excused from any strenuous activities for 2 weeks from the day of vaccination.

8. <u>EZ Link School Smart Card Photo-Taking Exercise for P1 & P6 Students on 25 Jan (Thu)</u>

The individual student smart card photo-taking exercise for P1 and P6 students will be held on 25 Jan (Thu).

Students can come to school in their PE attire if they have PE lessons on that day. They can then bring a set of school uniform to change before their photo-taking session.

9. Chinese New Year (CNY) Celebrations on 9 Feb (Fri) - Early school dismissal at 10.30 am

There will be a school-based CNY celebration on 9 Feb (Fri). As it is the eve of CNY, school hours would be from 7.30 am to 10.30 am.

School will close for CNY on 12 Feb (Mon) and 13 Feb (Tue). Classes will only resume on 14 Feb (Wed).
