Dear Parents/Guardians

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT AND ROAD SAFETY JOINT ADVISORY 2024

We would like to seek your cooperation to work with the school to ensure road safety for our students.

We seek your help by observing the following safety guidelines:

1. Exercise Consideration for Other Road Users and Pedestrians:

- a. Cooperate with traffic marshals to ensure overall safety and smooth traffic flow.
- b. Alight your child at designated drop-off points inside the school; avoid pick-ups/drop-offs along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 9 (AMK Ave 9).
- c. Ensure that your child alights from the left side of the vehicle safely and quickly.
- d. Keep to the left lane while queuing to enter the school compound; avoid parking, waiting, or leaving vehicles along AMK Ave 9.
- e. Observe speed limits: Not more than 40 km/h along school zone (AMK Ave 9) and not more than 15 km/h within school premise.
- f. Always keep a lookout for pedestrians.
- g. Avoid reckless driving behaviours, including abrupt turns and illegal U-turns along AMK Ave 9.
- h. Time your arrivals to avoid forming traffic queues or waiting along AMK Ave 9. Vehicles will only be allowed into the school compound approximately 20 minutes after dismissal.

2. Educating Our Children on Good Road Safety Habits:

- a. Emphasize the importance of using proper pedestrian crossings.
- b. Discourage the use of mobile devices while crossing the road.
- c. Practice kerb drills before crossing the road: "look right, look left, look right again, ensure all vehicles have stopped, raise your hand high up and cross the road briskly"

3. Avoid Waiting/Parking in the Following Areas:

- a. Within yellow boxes (e.g., bus stop, outside school, Ang Mo Kio-Thye Hua Kwan Hospital (AMK-THK Hospital), or Nuovo condo).
- b. Within 3m from a fire-hydrant.
- c. Within 6m from a junction/vehicular access of AMK-THK Hospital or Nuovo condo.
- d. Within 9m of a bus stop.
- e. Single white zig-zag line (zebra-controlled zone).
- f. Along double yellow line to prevent congestion or obstruction to ambulance turning out from AMK-THK Hospital.
- g. At road bends, entrances or exits of any access; and
- h. Parking abreast to another vehicle.

Any form of waiting without immediate pick-up or drop-off activity along the road, even with the driver in the vehicle or hazard lights on, is considered parking under the Road Traffic Act. Please arrive at the school only when ready for immediate pick-ups/drop-offs. If waiting is necessary, please consider using nearby HDB carparks to avoid fines.

Under the current Road Traffic Act/Rules, any violation of the above guidelines constitutes a traffic offence, and the authorities will take necessary action against errant drivers based on feedback.

We appreciate your understanding and adherence to these guidelines, contributing to the overall safety of our students and the community. Thank you for playing a vital role in keeping our road safe.
