### 1. Celebrating Our Students' Achievements

Our students have done well in both the academic and non-academic domains, and we would like to send them our congratulations.

#### North Zone and National Primary Schools Sports Championships 2017

- i. Our Junior Boys and Senior Boys Basketball Teams have come in 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> respectively in the Zonal Championships. Currently, both teams have clinched places in the Top 8 in the National Championships.
- ii. For National Inter-school Taekwondo Championship, Lee Ling Xuan, Ezanne (P6.4) achieved Silver in the Senior Girls Division, and Lim Ze Yuan, Caleb (P6.1) attained Bronze in the Senior Boys Division. Ang Yi Xin, Shermaine (P4.4) and Chua Ting Yi, Erin (P3.1) participated in the Junior Girls Division.

- vi. For Dance Sports Competition, Hazel Tan Rou En (P3.6) was a semi-finalist at the 3rd National Dancesport Competition for Primary Schools.

#### **6. P3 to P6 Sports Carnival / P1 & P2 Home-based Learning (26 May, Friday)**

#### **7. Overseas Learning Journey to Shanghai (20 May, Saturday to 25 May, Thursday)**

A group of P4 and P5 student leaders will embark on this overseas learning journey (OLJ) jointly organised by the Mother Tongue Department and Character and Citizenship Education Department. This OLJ aims to develop global awareness in our student leaders as they immerse themselves in Shanghai, known to be the most influential economic, financial, international trade, and cultural center in East China. Through authentic learning interactions with local students in schools and cultural visits, it will enable our students to become more adaptable when interacting with people from different cultural backgrounds as they embrace learning opportunities with Courage and Sincerity.

### **8. Term 2 June Holiday (27 May to 26 June)**

Students will be taking their Term 2 School Holiday from 27 May to 26 June. During this period, your child/ward may be involved in various school programmes. The respective teachers-in-charge will issue letters to inform you through your child/ward of the details of the activities.

After the Term 2 school holiday, all students will report to school on Tuesday, 27 June for the start of Term 3. Monday, 26 June is a public holiday, the day after Hari Raya Puasa.

### **9. SNAC Registration**

You would have received our letter in Apr that we are adopting a smartphone communication system for all parents/guardians. This smartphone communication system **SNAC™** or **Smart Notification Acknowledgement Console**, allows us to achieve a higher level of communication effectiveness and workflow efficiency in our information dissemination and communication with you and promotes green for the environment in paper reduction. You will be able to receive PDF attachment, message notification, and event notification such as e-consent form, and appointment slots from us. This app will allow us to receive your feedback in real-time, track notification read/unread status and take proactive measure to contact you on emergency matters should the notification not reach you within the stimulated time.
