Please be informed that ALL P1 to P5 students will embark on Home-Based Learning (HBL) during the PSLE Marking Exercise School Holidays (19 to 24 October 2017) on the AsknLearn portal (http://lms.asknlearn.com/Anderson_ps/).

The primary objective of this HBL is to engage the pupils meaningfully in their continual revision during the school closure and prepare them for the upcoming examinations in Semester 2. We hope to promote self-directed learning and encourage students to take an active role in their learning.

1) What is Home-Based Learning?

Home-Based Learning (HBL) takes place in the homes of students as it engages pupils meaningfully during an unscheduled school closure or non-school days. Unlike classroom learning, there is no (or little) face-to-face interaction between students and teachers in HBL. Learning content is delivered digitally via learning portal(s).

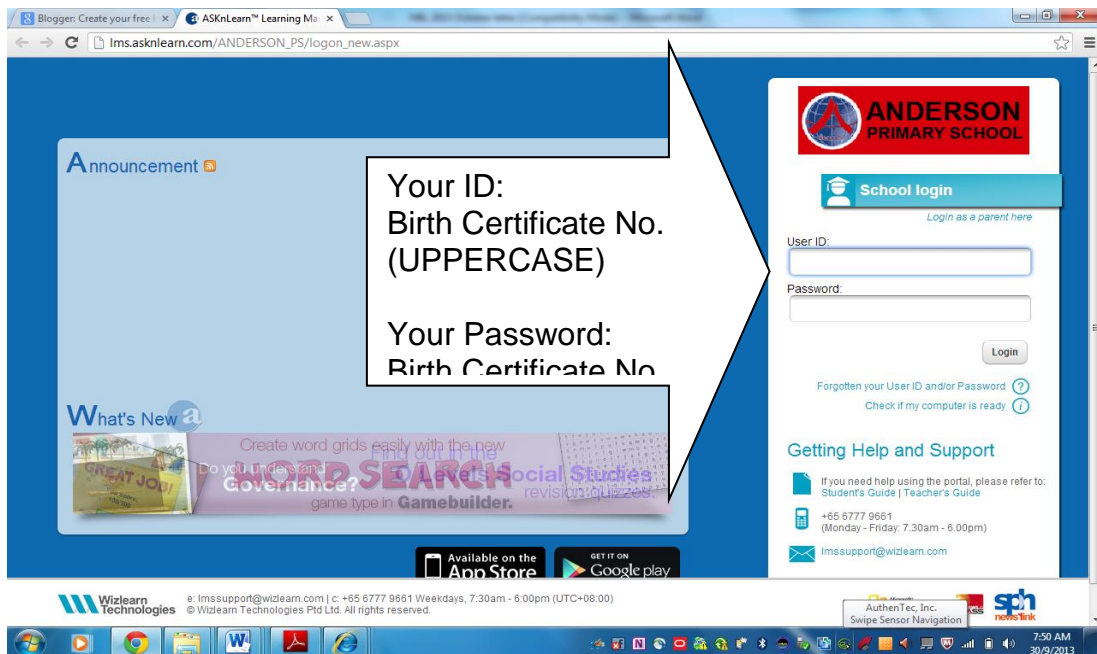
7) What if the child has no computing devices or Internet access at home?

Computer Laboratory 1 (for P1 to P5 pupils) will be open to students on a first-come-first-serve basis from the 19 October to 20 October 2017 and 23 October to 24 October 2017 respectively from 9 am to 12 pm and 1 pm to 4 pm. At any point of time, each laboratory is able to accommodate a maximum of 40 pupils only.

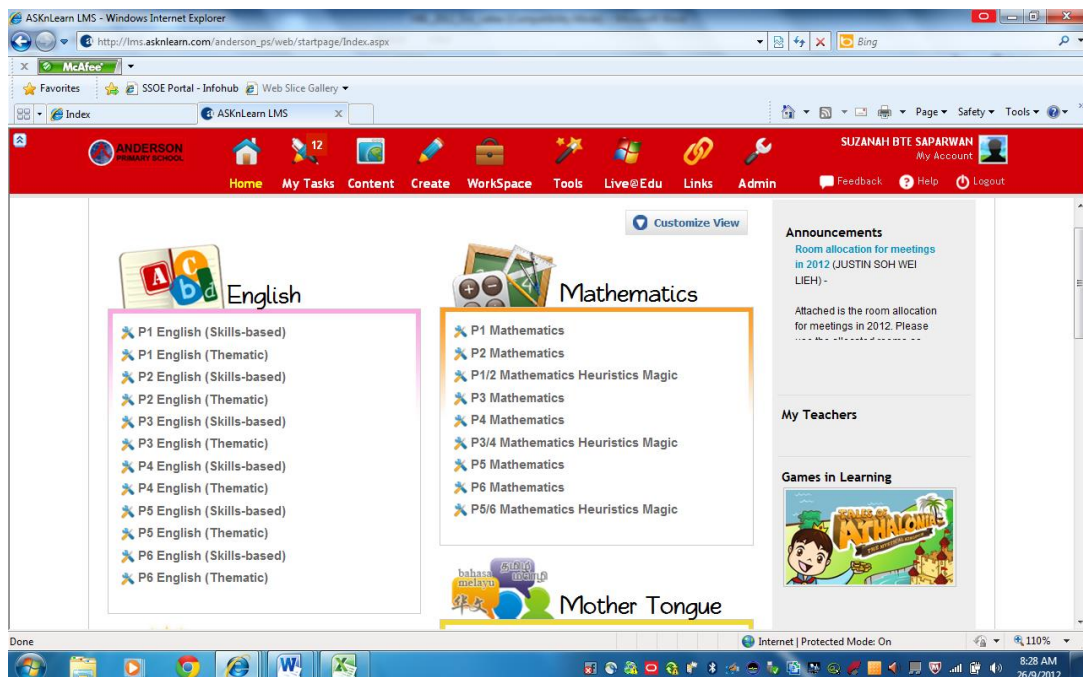
Pupils are required to sign in when they enter the laboratory and sign out before they leave the laboratory. Parents/Guardians are to make the necessary transportation and/ or lunch arrangements for their children on their own if necessary. Please take note that not all school's canteen vendors may operate on those days. Please ensure that your child/ward's lunch is arranged should your child/ward stay the whole day.

Instructions for retrieving the Home-Based Learning tasks

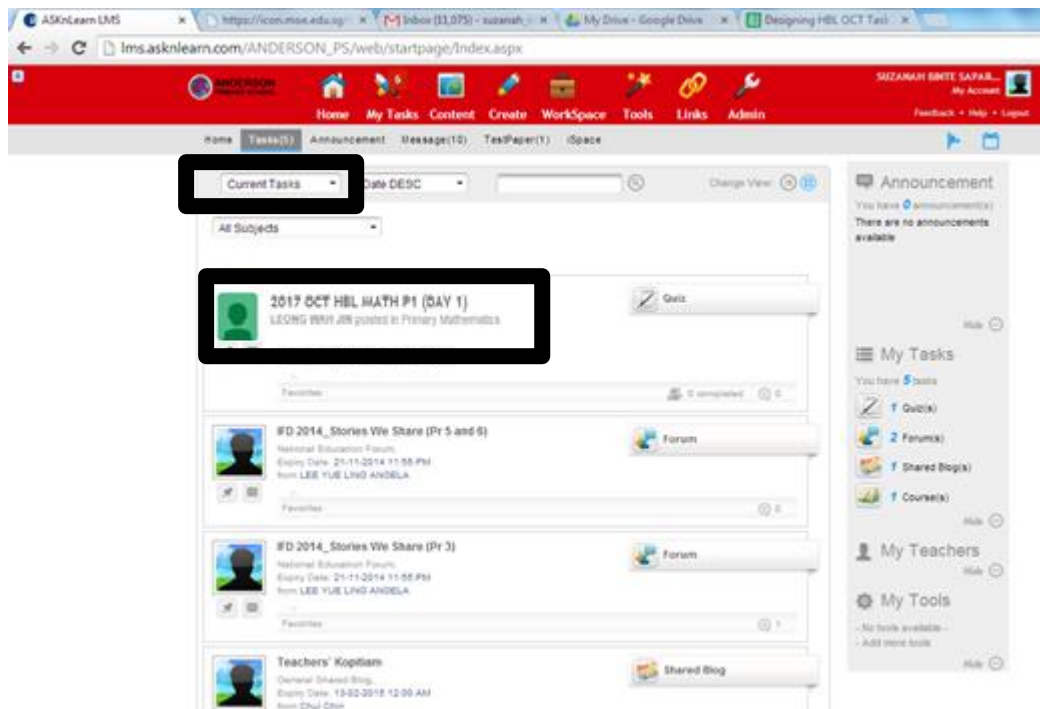
- 1) Logon to the AsknLearn Portal
http://lms.asknlearn.com/Anderson_ps/



- 2) Click on "My Tasks"



- 3) Select “Current Tasks” – to do the assigned tasks
Click on the title of the assigned lesson to assess to the HBL tasks
e.g. 2017 OCT HBL P1 MATH (Day 1)



- 4) Select “Completed Tasks” – to view or edit the tasks that have been completed/ submitted (for tasks that you have attained a ‘pass’) **or**
Select “Current Tasks” – to view or edit the tasks that have been completed/ submitted (for tasks you have not attained a ‘pass’)

Click on the title of the assigned lesson to assess to the HBL tasks
